Rule Clarifications All teams must impound their planes at the start of the event. Teams will draw numbers to determine launch order. A prefabricated kit may be utilized to build the plane. The maximum wing span for the plane is 16 inches. Only wood, paper, and adhesive are permitted in the design of the body and wings. The plane may be painted, however decals are not permitted. The propeller and rubber band may be attached to the body with metallic pieces. Only one propeller is permitted, it may be made of plastic. The maximum size of the rubber band shall be 1/8" in width and 7" in length (14" circumference). Rubber bands must be commercially purchased; teams shall provide an extra rubber band to judges prior to launch.
